The contribution is part of a three-year pledge to fund the ReelAbilities Film Festival National Program ("ReelAbilities National").

Initiated in NY in 2007, the festivals present award winning films by and about people with disabilities in multiple locations throughout each hosting city, and have been hosted in Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Cincinnati, Columbus, Greater D.C., Houston, Minneapolis/St. Paul, New Jersey, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, and Richmond.

Jeffrey P. Harris, Saul Schottenstein's nephew and a trustee of the foundation, believes the contribution furthers the foundations' mission to foster consciousness of our connection and humanity through the arts. The films presented will feature a public service announcement by Jason Harris, co-founder of Jason's Connection, an online service dedicated to the special needs community and funded by Saul Schottenstein Foundation B.
